

Bauer Leadership Fellows Program

The Bauer Leadership Fellows program is designed to help students advance their leadership capacity and refine and understand their values and strengths. CEL Practicum Team Leads and CEL Scholars are eligible to participate in the program.

Why become a Bauer Leadership Fellow?

- Earn course credit for your leadership experience
- Receive designation as a *Bauer Leadership Fellow* (with graduation medallion and certificate) to signal your leadership capabilities to the market
- Work with an exclusive group of top student leaders
- Participate in intensive leadership experiences designed to stretch you and advance your insight and capabilities
- Learn to solve immediate problems faced as a CEL Team Lead and develop your skills
- Gain access to faculty and executive mentors who can help you develop

Program Requirements

The program follows the 70/20/10 model of leadership development by combining challenging leadership experiences (70%), developmental relationships (20%), and coursework and training (10%) to develop your leadership capacity.

- 1) **Complete OB B66/566 “Leadership in the Trenches: Learning to Lead through Experience and Feedback”** as a companion to your CEL Leadership experience (or a comparable, concurrent leadership experience)
- 2) **Enroll in and complete MGT 572 “Defining Moments: Lessons in Leadership and Character from the Top” during your MBA program (1.5 credits)**
 - Offered in Spring Mini A and typically taken during second year
 - Note: if you anticipate a December graduation, this can be adjusted (please contact the BLC Program Manager)
- 3) **Enroll in and complete one additional leadership-related course from the list below.** This does not have to be completed concurrently with being a CEL Team Lead.
