

Bauer Leadership Fellows Program

The Bauer Leadership Fellows program is designed to help students advance their leadership capacity and refine and understand their values and strengths. All CEL Team Leads and CEL Fellows are eligible to participate in the program.

Why become a Bauer Leadership Fellow?

- Work with an exclusive group of top student leaders
- Earn course credit for your leadership experience
- Earn designation a *Bauer Leadership Fellow* (with certificate) to signal your leadership capabilities to the market
- Have access to intensive leadership experiences designed to stretch you and advance your insight and capabilities
- Learn to solve immediate problems faced as CEL team leaders, while developing long term skills
- Gain access to faculty and executive mentors who can help you develop

Program Design

The program follows the 70/20/10 model of leadership development. The program combines challenging leadership experiences (70%), developmental relationships (20%), and coursework and training (10%) to develop your leadership capacity.

- 1) Leadership in the Trenches: Learning to Lead through Experience and Feedback OB (B66) 566**
(Receive 1.5 course credits by completing [all 3 requirements](#) below)
 - a) Attend all Captains' Chair Meetings (CEL & BLC)
 - b) Participate in a half-day Leadership Experience through the BLC
 - c) Complete a four-page reflection assignment by end of semester
- 2) Bauer Leadership Certificate** (receive certificate by completing [all 3 requirements](#) below)
 - a) Complete Leadership in the Trenches course as outlined above
 - b) Enroll in and complete the Defining Moments course during your MBA program (1.5 credits).
 - MGT 572, Offered in Spring Mini A. Typically taken during 2nd year.
 - c) Enroll in and complete one additional leadership-related course from the list below during your MBA program. Does not have to be completed concurrently with being CEL team leader.

 - OB 524 Negotiation
 - OB 530 Creative Thinking and Leading Creative Organizations

 - d) Bauer Leadership Center will create opportunities for students to engage, network, and form possible mentorships with visiting executives.
